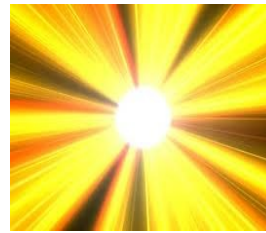

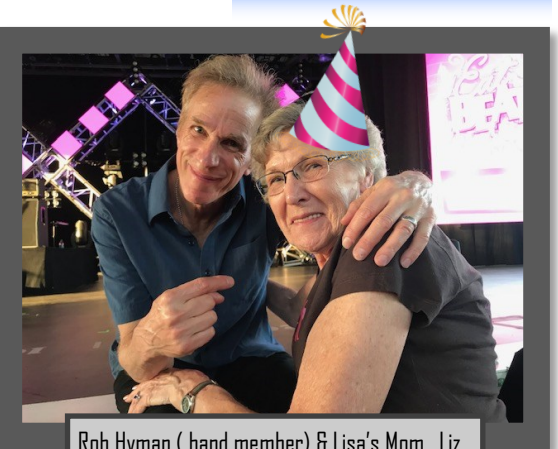




Celebrating with Mom and The Hooters by Lisa Distefano, Client Services Associate

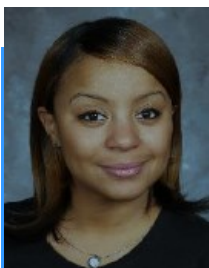
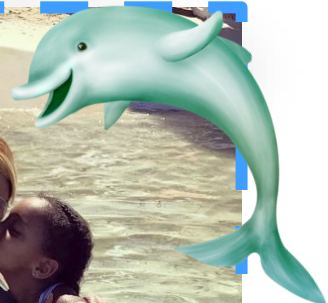
